The Legislature meets each year beginning the second Monday in January. The regular session is limited to 105 days in odd-numbered years and 60 days in even-numbered years. The Governor or the Legislature may call additional special sessions lasting no more than 30 days each as needed.

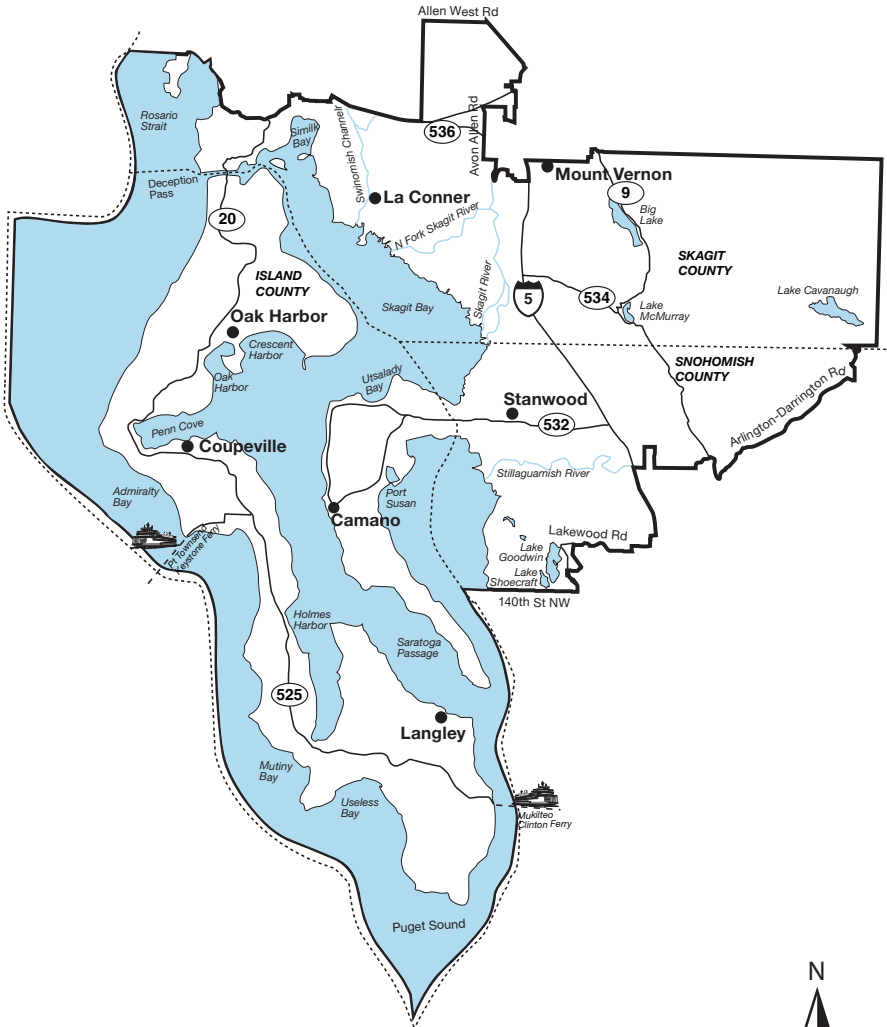
